



Ageing Population in Australia

• 10% in RACF (~200,000)

• > 1.5 m live in community alone

• Retirement Village Living

Loss of the "extended family" and "village"

Residential Aged Care

• 40% no visitors

>50% have depression/ anxiety symptoms

• 20 hours a day in their room

What do we know about Intergenerational Contact?

The purposeful bringing together of different generations for the benefit of all

- Level 1 : Activities in the same physical space Level 2 : Interaction occurs- unidirectional
- (eg children perform)
- Level 3 : Two generations work together on a same project
- Level 4 : Learning environment is shared to meet the learning goals of different generations

Intergenerational Contact

- Employed variably world-wide
- Childcare / preschool / school visits to RACF
- Playgroups in RACF
- Co-location of young and old (eg students)
- Programmes for school children and older adults

Benefits?

- WHO "Active Ageing Framework
- Evidence Base "Patchy" \rightarrow Evolving

Older adults -mood, sense of self, behaviour, engagement

Children- Perceptions of Aging*, reduced antisocial behaviour

Intergenerational Programmes in Australia

- Limited now growing*
- Usually in RACF
- Not usually a formalised programme based on educational pedagogy
- Limited/ no monitoring of participant outcomes

WHO?

 11 x residents (aged 78-96) from both ILU and RACF at ANZAC Lifecare

• 10 x preschool students (aged 4)

WHAT?

• An intergenerational classroom over **7 weeks**

• 4 days a week

• 9-3pm



HOW?

Adhered to Preschool Curriculum

Structured and unstructured activities

• Sports carnival

• Concert!

What did we measure?

- Geriatric Depression Scale
- Grip Strength
- Balance
- Gait speed
- Physical activity via pedometer

What did we find?

- GDS 3 out 4 of no longer screened positive
- Overall reduction >2 points on 15-point GDS
- 80% increased grip strength, gait speed, step count
- 50% improved balance
- Children → confidence, ?empathy

Series 2 (2021)



Old Peoples Home Series 2

- 11 x Community dwelling older adults
- Aged up to 91
- 10 local preschool students aged 4
- Similar intervention → bigger emphasis on children and the what happens afterwards

What did we measure?

• Mood- GDS 5

• Quality of Life (10 point scale)

• Frailty (Fried phenotype)

What did we find

• Older adults

Significant positive changes in: *frailty, mood, quality of life*

Children

Improved pro-social skills, vocabulary
